

River levels in the Wandle

5th October 2018

We are working together to improve the Wandle in this area for people and wildlife.

Plans for the Millfields Redrow development include alterations to Goat Bridge Weir which will improve the habitat and fish passage on the Wandle. The realignment of the Wandle Trail with the river is also proposed to improve access to the riverside for the local community.

Over the next month, we will be investigating the impact that current river levels have on Spencer Road Wetlands. This will help inform the future plans for Goat Bridge Weir.

We will be slowly lowering Goat Bridge Weir from Monday 8 October 2018 and it will be raised again on 22 October 2018. During this time, you will see gradual changes to the water levels in this stretch. We anticipate that the river will return to normal levels around 1 November 2018.

We will be actively monitoring the river throughout this period, with support from the Wandle Trust (part of the South East Rivers Trust).
